Hello Hudson League!

It is time to get busy! But first a couple corrections: The Mayer/City Manager meeting tonight at the Library is from 6:00 - 7:30. This is a city sponsored meeting. Also: there is a change to the location for the September 14th 10:30 a.m. member meeting. We will be at City Hall (1140 Terex Road). The meeting room entrance is around the back of the building.



LWV Ohio is working with a group called Citizens Not Politicians working to redraw Ohio's districts for fairer representation. LWV Ohio asked Leagues to collect 1000 signatures over a weekend. 7,800 signatures were collected statewide. Leagues are again being asked to collect 1000 signatures. I have offered Hudson's services and am organizing a drive-thru signature event for next Wednesday and/or Thursday. A Sign-Up Genius will be sent on Tuesday. Or contact me if you want to get petitions signed.


Next Member Meeting: Sept 14, 10:30am
