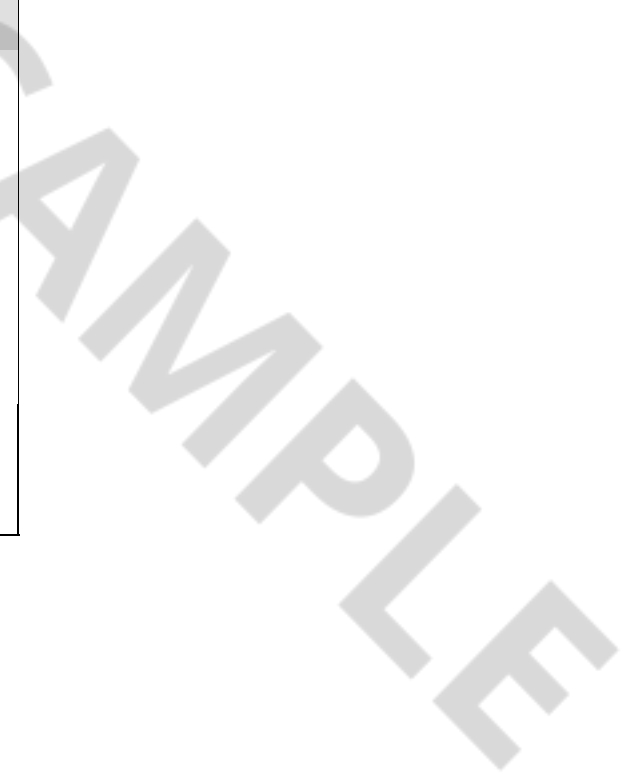

Instructions to Voter
• To vote: completely darken the oval (●) to the left of your choice.
• Do not mark the ballot for more choices than allowed. Vote either "Yes" or "No," or "For" or "Against," on any issue.
• If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that question will not be counted.
• If you make a mistake or want to change your vote: return your ballot to an election official and get a new ballot. You may ask for a new ballot up to two times.

OFFICIAL QUESTIONS AND ISSUES BALLOT

Issue 12
Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal and Increase) City of Hudson
A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.
A renewal of 2.9 mills and an increase of 0.6 mill for each \$1 of taxable value to constitute a tax for the benefit of the City of Hudson for the purpose of supporting the free public library of the Hudson Library and Historical Society that the county fiscal officer estimates will collect \$3,692,699 annually, at a rate not exceeding 3.5 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$78 for each \$100,000 of the county fiscal officer's market value, for 5 years, commencing in 2026, first due in calendar year 2027.
