Special qualifications required: Any person is eligible to be a School Board Trustee, without further qualifications, if he/she is 18 years of age or older, a citizen of the state, a resident of the school district, a registered voter and not legally disqualified from holding civil office.

Length of term: The term of office for Board members elected in regular elections shall be four years, commencing on the second Friday in December following their election.
