

CANDIDATE INFRINGEMENT LETTER

Dear

I write you on behalf of the [League of Women's Voters of . . .] We recently learned that your campaign has posted an edited version of your participation in the [Date] . . . This is in violation of the Talent Release Form you signed for your participation in the [Date] Forum. (A copy of the Form is enclosed for your reference.) Please immediately remove all versions of this edited video from your website, YouTube, and any other venues. (Concurrently, the League itself is filing with YouTube a take-down request for this edited video.)

Your campaign website may link to the Candidates Forum video provided that (1) your site presents the video in its **entirety**, (2) the video neither starts nor stops automatically within the video's full runtime, (3) your site clearly identifies the video as the [Date] [NAME OF CANDIDATE FORUM], and (4) your site clearly states that this use of the video is by permission of the [League of Women Voters of . . .]
