All public-school districts have many legal responsibilities. These must be taken care of “at the district level,” meaning they require the review or approval of the district’s school board. They include the following:

- Selection of curriculum materials
- Staff assignments, employee hires and dismissals, labor negotiations and contracts (teachers, principals, and other staff are all employees of the school district)
- Monitoring both revenues and expenditures
- Compliance with state and federal laws, including regulations related to dozens of categorical programs which range from special education to school lunches
- Management of the district’s real property and facilities

Number of elected officials: Five

Durham Demographics:

At the 2010 census Durham had a population of 5,518. The population density was 67.3 people per square mile (26.0/km²). The racial makeup of Durham was 5,088 (92.2%) White, 19 (0.3%) African American, 55 (1.0%) Native American, 35 (0.6%) Asian, 9 (0.2%) Pacific Islander, 165 (3.0%) from other races, and 147 (2.7%) from two or more races. Hispanic or Latino of any race were 614 people (11.1%).

Length of term: 4 Years

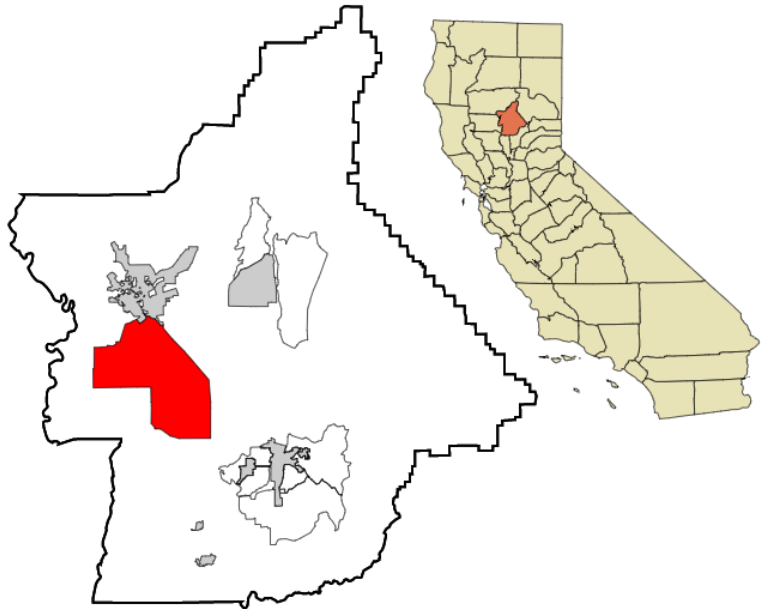
Financial Compensation: The members of the board view their board service as a voluntary contribution to the community and elect not to receive compensation.
