

# Know Your Rights Fact Sheet

1. You have the right to ask to see a warrant.
2. ICE cannot enter private spaces like your home, school or private area of your workplace without a Judicial Warrant that says, “US District Court,” and is signed by a judge.
3. If ICE does not have a judicial warrant, SIGNED by a judge, you have the right to say, “I do not consent to entry” and the right to keep your door closed.
4. Sometimes ICE will show you paperwork that is a “Warrant of Removal Deportation” and tell you that they have the right to arrest you. That is FALSE. ICE is legally allowed to lie to you. You have the RIGHT to remain SILENT.
5. If you are being detained, you may always ask “Am I free to go” repeatedly until they answer you.
6. You are allowed to legally film ICE if you DO NOT interfere with an arrest.
7. It is important to remain CALM with any interaction with ICE or law enforcement. Do NOT impede their investigation, resist arrest or run.
8. You can call 911.
9. Have a plan with family or friends, legal representation, memorize a phone number.
