Ms. Pope will discuss Operations and Timeline, Recruiting, and Outreach for the 2020 Census.

Stephanie Swanson, LWV TX Redistricting Issue Chair and a leader of Fair Maps Texas, will speak to the general impact of the census on redistricting and provide an overview of redistricting. She will also address litigation that conflates partisan with racial boundaries.



Tracy Westen, J.D. is a member of the National Governing Board of Common Cause and Adjunct Professor at UCLA Law School and USC Annenberg School for Communication. He was involved in creating the Redistricting Commission in California. Mr. Westen will discuss the fine points of redistricting, some of the challenges, and some solutions.
