At the 2010 census, the population makeup of Gridley was 4,283 (65.1%) White, 55 (0.8%) African American, 98 (1.5%) Native American, 249 (3.8%) Asian, 3 (0.0%) Pacific Islander, 1,552 (23.6%) from other races, and 344 (5.2%) from two or more races. Hispanic or Latino of any race were 3,000 persons (45.6%).

Special qualifications required: Candidates for local office must fulfill the following requirements: (1) be citizens of the United States, (2) registered voters, (3) live within Gridley city limits, and (4) be 18 years of age or older.
