- January 15 meeting: 5-year Strategic Planning brochure will be distributed through the Viking Connection. Life safety amendment approved. Administration of Medication to Students policy 6512 approved. March 22 Institute Day agenda approved. Extended Field Trip for Girls Track and Field approved. Extended responsibility contracts and monthly expenditures were also approved.
- February 14 meeting: Out of school suspension and in school suspension was approved for a student. In another action a student was expelled for the rest of the year and will be allowed to re-enter next school year under a special Delta Program.

February 19:
