



How do I vote by mail?

- For 2018, absentee ballot applications will NOT be automatically mailed to voters, so you will have to request one.
- You can request an absentee application by calling your Board of Elections or download and print one at bit.ly/OhAbsentee
- The absentee application deadline is Sat. May. 5 at 12 noon, but it is best to send it in early so you have time to receive your ballot in the mail.
- Your county Board of Elections (BOE) will process your application and send you an absentee ballot. If you sent in your application but have not yet received a ballot, call your BOE to make sure they received your application.
- Completed absentee ballots must be postmarked by Mon. May. 7 if mailed or can be dropped off at the Board of Elections (but NOT at local polling places) by Tue. May. 8 at 7:30pm.
