Voter turnout was one of the highest in Mason County history with an impressive 85.3% of the 44,161 registered voters casting their ballot this year. The Auditor's outstanding staff proved up for the challenge.

Not only did they register voters, assist candidates, process ballots, and educate the public on the voting process, they also implemented substantial changes in order to accommodate the citizens during a pandemic. Talk to any one of the staff and you'll see why they are well suited for this most important task. They are accessible, impeccably trained, and passionate about informing voters.

In addition to conducting four elections this year, (see RCW 29A.8.110), the Elections staff unveiled a new Facebook site to keep citizens informed, register voters online, clarify misinformation, and track voters' ballots online.
