List of seven acceptable photo voter IDs—not expired more than 4 years List of other documents accepted if no photo ID & willing to sign a simple form Name on ID and voter registration card must be essentially the same but not identical Voter addresses on ID and official list of voters need not match at time of voting Election officials and poll workers may not question voter about voter ID issues
