During this past year we expanded our monthly programs to include topics that are relevant to our rural community. These included increasing the minimum wage in Grand County, a panel discussion about successful urban planning, the future of the Affordable Care Act, and an update to the Moab City Water Conservation master plan. We also held two consensus study groups-sexual violence and public defense in Utah, along with a program on how to become a more effective advocate and citizen.

In October we hosted our 35th Annual Candidates Forum. It was the largest group of candidates ever invited (county and state) and the largest audience, estimated at 150 plus. Both local papers covered the event and it was rebroadcast on local TV.

We just wrapped up our only fundraiser for the year, a silent auction and "buy now" event, held the same evening as the first art walk of the year. It looks like it's going to be the second highest fundraiser in the history of our local league. We are very happy about that. The money will be used for the candidate's forum and our monthly educational programs.

Like many league chapters, we have seen our membership increase over the past few years. The board is working hard to create an expanded framework to communicate with and engage our members more effectively.
