- Educate the membership and community about Fair Voting Maps and advocate League's position
- Encourage people to seek election or appointment to public office in order to have a representative government.
- Promote voter interest, education, registration, and turnout.
- Promote accessible, affordable, and preventive health care.
- Research, inform the public, and communicate with legislators about: the need for sufficient state funding, the impact of vouchers, and the adequate quality of teacher preparation to meet the needs of public education.
- Commit to Observer Corps members attending Brown County Board and Green Bay City Council meetings. Reports from observers at other Brown County area meeting, will be accepted.
