EARLY VOTING ADVOCACY

The implementation of <u>Early Voting</u> is one of the top priorities for the League at both the state and local levels. Here at the local level, we have kept in close contact with our state leaders to make sure we were aware of key elements of EV implementation that the league is supporting and tracking. There has been action in the Appropriations Committee and the Government Administration and Elections Committee (GAE). On February 16 the Appropriations Committee held a hearing on the Governor's budget. The submitted budget did not include money for EV implementation. Patricia Rossi, VP of Advocacy for LWVCT, testified in person about the importance of funding so that EV is not an unfunded mandate falling on the shoulders of municipalities. Several LWVGH Board members submitted written testimony with the same message. On February 22, the GAE Committee will hold a hearing on bills to implement EV. The LWVCT has issued an Action Alert to encourage league members to submit testimony to amplify the LWV message. Use this link to submit.
