Advocacy Update

Status of LWVCT priority action items.

- (1.) <u>SB753</u> to end prison-based gerrymandering. Passed the Senate and House. Action: Check the vote tally sheet, thank your legislators who voted in favor: <u>SB753 Vote Tally</u>.
- (2.) HJ58 (NEAV) and HJ59 (Early Voting). Both passed the House and go to the Senate. Contact your Senator to support these measures to make voting more accessible to all eligible Connecticut voters. Contact your House member: if they supported these, thank them; if they opposed, politely express your disappointment. HJ58 Tally Sheet; HJ59 Tally Sheet
- (3.) <u>Support SB5</u> to make our elections more accessible, safe and secure by improving online registration and voter list maintenance through the DMV and other agencies; Improving processes for applying for and handling of absentee ballots; and enfranchising people on parole by supporting court fees being waived, as they are in MA, RI, New Hampshire and several other states; VT and Maine permit all prisoners to vote.
