HOW to Register to Vote

- Must be a U.S. citizen
- Must be 18 years old on or by the next election day;
 November 3, 2020 General Election
- Must be a PA resident for 30 days prior to the next election
- Must have a PennDOT ID number, PA Driver's License number, OR the last four digits of your Social Security Number

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
CHOICE #1—Complete the **Online Form** if you have a PA Driver's License or PennDOT ID. (Your signature will be on file.)




(Complete the shaded areas)

- PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY; Use black pen.
- When printing dates, use 4 digits for the year.
- BIRTH DATE is required (18 years old on or by next election day).
- Phone number and email are not required but are recommended if the County Election Office needs to contact you.
- County is required.
- Complete all checked boxes (like "Eligibility" and "Reason").
- Only one form of ID is required: EITHER your Driver's License or PennDot ID OR Last 4 digits of your Social Security Number.

IMPORTANT:

In the BOX, write your SIGNATURE, Clearly PRINT YOUR NAME below, Write TODAY'S DATE below that.

**Because Pennsylvania has Closed Primaries, you must enroll in one of the two main political parties, either Democratic or Republican, to participate in the spring primary, unless there is a ballot question, constitutional amendment, or special election.

Put the Presidential General Election, November 3, 2020 in your phone calendar NOW!

Last day to register to vote is October 19, 2020.

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
This official looking **ENVELOPE** will hold your Voter Registration ID Card.

After you send in your Voter Registration Application, and after you turn 18 years old, it may take **3 weeks** before you receive this envelope in the mail with your **VOTER REGISTRATION ID CARD** inside.

Remember to look for it!

• If you don't receive your ID card after that time, contact your county election office. (The Allegheny County Elections Office can be reached at 412-350-4500.)





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This sample **VOTER REGISTRATION ID CARD**;

 shows your address, which political party you have chosen, if any (in capitals), and your polling place.
