

- (3) LWVOA Advocacy/Observer Corps: Wednesday, 7/20/2022 at 5:30p via zoom. Advocacy is supporting criminal justice & bail reform and working to create an Observer Corps to observe Oakland Area school boards. YOUR SERVICE IS NEEDED: If you are concerned about how your local school board is functioning, this is an opportunity to learn what you should be looking for at meetings and report your findings back to the League and Advocacy in case action is needed. Observers observe they do not speak at meetings, the key skills are listening, taking notes, and reporting back in a timely fashion. Remember that many school board meetings are now also held online, so you can often observe from home. Interested in being a part of this new and important LWVOA activity?
