Convention Awards

The Powering Democracy Awards will be presented at the 2022 Convention in recognition of Leagues for their exemplary work over the past biennium. All winners will receive a cash prize from LWVUS in recognition of their work. Finalists will be selected by LWVUS staff, and winners will be selected by the public poll.

LWV Program for 2022 – 24

League program is the education and advocacy platform that we adopt every national Convention to move our mission forward. The LWVUS board is recommending the readoption of the Campaign for Making Democracy Work® as LWV Program for 2022 – 2024. Find the [full proposed program on the Convention platform](#).

More than 300 Leagues participated in the LWVUS program planning process, and 100% of Leagues voted that LWVUS should continue prioritizing the Campaign for Making Democracy Work® in the next biennium.

Leagues had the opportunity to indicate another position or policy that LWVUS should work on. Staff will use those recommendations to shape the watchdog issues for LWVUS action. Leagues proposing not-recommended or other items must follow the requirements outlined in [LWVUS Bylaw XII Principles and Program Sec. 2\(c\)](#).
