Domestic Violence Services Advocacy

Vice President **Julie Trude** continues to lead our advocacy for domestic violence services, in cooperation with Connie Moore, Alexandra House Executive Director. Julie, **Leslie Waterhouse and Gretchen Sable** sent personalized letters to all legislators in our service area. Response was mixed, in part due to budget concerns.

Julie submitted our letter supporting \$20M in state funds for victims of crime to be part of the official record for hearings in the House/Senate. Julie also procured letters of support from Blaine Police Chief Podany and Anoka County Sheriff Wise. Senator Michael Kreun of Blaine read both letters into the record at the Senate Judiciary and Public Safety Committee. Sheriff Wise also attended the House hearing.

On Thursday, the Office of Minnesota Management and Budget released the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 biennium, projected to end with a \$3.7 billion surplus, which is \$1.3 billion more than the projections in November of 2023.

Agenda items covered at our monthly board meeting on February 26, 224 included:


- Arrangements have been finalized for March 11 program, via Zoom, with member Wes Volkenant on topic of metro area watersheds and water management organizations.


