Renew Your Membership


It is time to renew your League membership unless you are a new member that

Seven members of LWV ABC put on their party hats and costumes to attend the Alexandra House Hope Gala Masquerade Ball fundraiser on March 23rd at Leopold's Mississippi Gardens. Several of us "won" silent auction items while others donated directly.

Connie Moore, the Executive Director of Alexandra House spoke to us for our January program. We learned they face a funding crisis after a decline in grants.

Our league has been actively lobbying with Connie and local law enforcement to have domestic violence funding added to the supplemental budget. Thankfully, there is now \$10 million in the Governor's Supplemental Budget for victims of crime, including those suffering domestic and sexual abuse. The funding will only help for one year so our advocacy must continue to increase future state funding.
