LWV Position on Local News and Democracy

In 2023, LWV Washington completed a two year study entitled "The Decline of Local Newspapers and Its Impact on Democracy". The study found that the number of local newspapers and staffing of remaining newspapers continues to decline. Research links the decline of newspapers with a drop in voter participation, as well as less community engagement and greater political partisanship.

Following completion of the study, using the League consensus process, LWV Washington adopted a position on local news. In short, the position states that it is the responsibility of government to provide support under which credible local journalism can survive and thrive.

Since then, through the League concurrence process, the Washington position was adopted by first LWV Minnesota and then by LWV United States at the June 2024 Convention.






LWV ABC Book Club


SaltSmart

Salt from winter deicing practices, potassium chloride fertilizer and water softening equipment can contaminate drinking water, endanger wildlife and damage property.

Once salts containing chloride come in contact with water, that chloride is very strongly bound to the water. There is no natural or feasible way to pull existing salt out of our water bodies or to mitigate pollution once salt is put down. There is promise in collectively working toward best practices as individuals, communities and regions.




Celebrate Hispanic Heritage Month September 15 - October15

Hispanic Heritage Month initially began as a weeklong celebration in 1968 under President Lyndon Johnson. In 1988 President Ronald Reagan extended the week to a full 31 days — through Oct. 15 — keeping the Sept. 15 start date because it coincides with national independence day of Guatemala, Honduras, El Salvador, Nicaragua and Costa Rica. Mexico celebrates independence on the 16th, Chile on the 18th and Belize on the 21st.

Hispanic Heritage Month was enacted into law on August 17, 1988.


