Coon Rapids has been recognized as a Minnesota GreenStep City and received an award for advancing to become a Step 1 City. This designation recognizes the City's accomplishments in the direction of energy and resource sustainability.

Minnesota GreenStep Cities is a voluntary challenge, assistance and recognition program to help cities achieve their sustainability and quality-of-life goals. As one of 67 participating cities, the City of Coon Rapids is helping to lead the way in sustainability across the state of Minnesota. The City received the GreenStep City designation and award at the League of Minnesota Cities Annual Conference on June 20. Recycling Assistant Amanda Bednar and Recycling Coordinator Colleen Sinclair accepted the award.
