- November 5, Sun. 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.

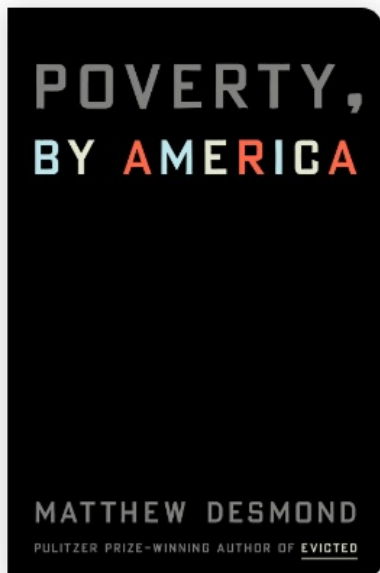

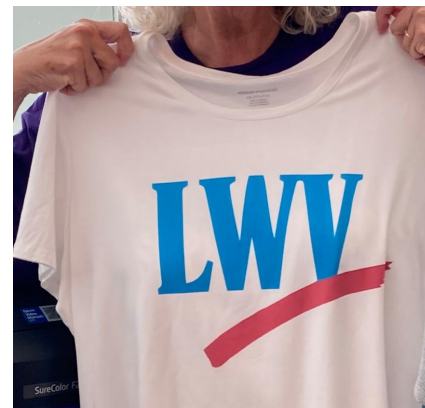
authorize its corporations to pay poverty wages? Desmond builds a startlingly original and ambitious case for ending poverty. [RSVP](#) please.
