
Oroville City Elementary School District

Board Member

The Board of Trustees believes that its primary responsibility is to act in the best, interests of every student in the district, The Board also has major commitments to parents/guardians, all members of the community," employees, the state of California, laws pertaining to public education, and established policies of the district to maximize Board effectiveness and public confidence in district governance. At the 2010 Census the population makeup was 11,686 (75.2%) White, 453 (2.9%) African American, 573 (3.7%) Native American, 1,238 (8.0%) Asian, 56 (0.4%) Pacific Islander, 554 (3.6%) from other races, and 986 (6.3%) from two or more races. Hispanic or Latino of any race were 1,945 persons (12.5%).

Special qualifications: Any person is eligible to be a Board of Trustees member, without further qualifications, if he/she is 18 years of age or older, a citizen of California, a resident of the school district, a registered voter, and not legally disqualified from holding civil office.

Length of term: 4 years

Financial compensation: Each member of the Governing Board may receive a monthly compensation of \$240. They receive reimbursement for expenses, and health and medical benefits at their own expense.

Board Meetings: Unless otherwise indicated, meetings will commence on the third Wednesday of every month at 5:00 p.m., and will be held in the Board Room at the Oroville City Elementary School District Office, located at 2795 Yard Street, Oroville, CA.
