### The League of Women Voters of Washington Is Hosting a Video Contest for Your Students

A civics-related video contest running from now to May 1st:

- Students produce a 30 – 60 second video on voting facts in Washington
- with 1st prize of \$300, 2nd prize \$150
- AND personal recognition for winning videos.

The contest runs until May 1, 2025, which is the deadline for both completed registrations and finished videos. Video production tutorials and guidance are available to all who register, so early registration is of real value.

The contest is sponsored by the League of Women Voters of Washington, part of a 100-year-old non-partisan organization which focuses on education, voting and other issues important to our democracy. Judging will be by a group, to include video professionals, election professionals and League members.

Cash Prizes

Our overall goal is to produce videos that LWVWA can use to promote election credibility to a broader audience.

As a result, we hope to encourage students to learn and share accurate information about Washington state voting and elections, and to become active voters.
