The RFP has not been drafted. It has two parts. Part one is for recreational programs like yoga on surfboards. It is the 75/25 split. Part two is a business called kiosk, which rents equipment. What are we going to charge a vendor to have their "Kiosk" here was discussed.

Parameters and data are being collected. This contract is unique because it is a business owner and Rec and Park partnership. Aspects of negotiations and contracts related to recreational programming were discussed.

The difficulty in finding suitable comparisons for the contract and the importance of clarity and understanding in contract terms were talked about.
