RETURN your Mail-In Ballot

IMPORTANT!

- Verify that your mail-in ballot is valid and ready to be RETURNED:
 - * Is your mail-in ballot inside the security envelope and is this envelope sealed?
 - * Is the sealed security envelope inside the sealed Official Election return envelope?
 - * Did you sign your declaration on the Official Election return envelope?
 - * Did you fill out the date, and print your name and address on the Official Election return envelope?
- If you don't think your RETURNED ballot will be received by the county Elections Office by the deadline (see below), you can vote in person at your polling place on Election Day, using a provisional ballot.

DEADLINE - For your completed mail-in ballot to be counted, it must be: POSTMARKED by 8:00pm on Election Day, November 3rd AND

RECEIVED by your county Elections Office by 5:00pm, November 6th

How? 2 Ways to RETURN

POSTAL MAIL

Put your mail-in ballot, contained in its 2 envelopes, into the postal mail

OSTAL WIAIL

Go to your county Elections Office to drop off your mail-in ballot, contained in

IMPORTANT!

 The U.S. Postal Service suggests that you mail your mail-in ballot at least 7 days before Election day.

Postmarks do not count!

 The Official Election return envelope has pre-paid postage - no stamp is necessary to send it!
