

How to Vote by Mail

If you are registered to vote already:

In DuPage County, all registered voters will receive an application for a vote by mail ballot automatically for the November election. Fill out the application and return it as soon as possible.

A vote by mail ballot is now the same as an absentee ballot.

Can I request a vote by mail ballot now?

Yes. Go to <https://www.dupageco.org/Election/VoteByMail/>.

If you are NOT registered to vote in DuPage County:

Register online at <https://ova.elections.il.gov>

When you register, you may request a vote by mail ballot at that time. You can also call to request a vote by mail ballot: English (630) 407-5600, or Spanish at (630) 407-5608. Make sure you are registered online by October 18th in order to vote in the November election. The last day to request a vote by mail ballot is October 29.

Is vote by mail safe?

Yes. Your signature on the ballot envelope is matched to your signature on file.

When will I get my ballot in the mail?

Requested vote by mail ballots will be mailed on September 24th.

How do I return my vote by mail ballot?

An envelope will be provided for you to mail in the ballot by US Mail. No postage is needed. Be sure to sign the envelope. The ballot must be postmarked by November 3 and received within 14 days. You may also drop off the ballot at an early voting location, at a regular voting location on November 3, or by driving to the DuPage County Complex, 421 N County Farm Road, Wheaton, and putting the ballot in a box provided.

How can I change my address?

Go to <https://ova.elections.il.gov> to register again. There is a form available for address changes that can be mailed. You may not do this over the phone.
