First aired in January 2024, this film investigates the hidden story of plastic and its effect on human health. In an era of throw away ease, convenience has cost us our well being. *We're All Plastic People Now* asks the question how much evidence do we need before we decide to take action?

<u>Vote411.org</u>, LWV's online Voter Guide, is ready for voters to use! To see candidates and ballot issues that will appear on your ballot, just click the *Find What's On Your Ballot* tab and enter your address. You will find candidates' biographies or General Information, Q&A, and, for candidates running for federal office, a Campaign Finance section. Campaign Finances is a new addition to Vote411.

The printed Voter Guide is also available to voters at the Way Public Library. If you received your copy of the Voter Guide in the *Perrysburg Messenger Journal* (PMJ), or if you picked up a copy at the library, you will have noticed the Guide is smaller than in previous years. There is a reason for that — deadlines.

For our printed Voter Guide, we download the candidate information from Vote411. Our deadline to submit information to the PMJ — who does an amazing job of taking our information and formatting it — is much earlier than candidate deadlines for Vote411. Thus, when we need the information for PMJ, it is just not available on Vote411.

Over the last few years, in our printed Voter Guide, we have been directing voters to Vote411 while still providing some Q&A with candidates. This year we decided to take another step forward and focus on the information that was available by the deadline. Since candidate biographies and Q&A was not available, we shrunk the size of the Guide and directed voters to Vote411.

<u>Vote411.org</u> is an extremely useful and easy to use voter tool. Please read it and share it with your contacts — even in other states. Leagues across the country are all using Vote411. It is a great resource in becoming an informed voter!


Per WCBOE's text flyer, here's what to expect:

1. After the initial keyword is sent, you will receive a confirmation message asking you to reply YES to verify opt-in.

2. You may receive multiple text messages a month with notification. Notifications may include polling place updates, election information, or other time sensitive voter notices.

3. You can text STOP at any time to remove yourself from the notification list.
