

Travel Time Disparity by Race and Mode (2010-2014 Avg)


African-Americans on average spend 64 hours more per person annually commuting on buses than white bus riders.






#### Why people would support more revenue

#### Access to jobs varies across the state






### Big Money Raising Options Why should we do it?

Revenue Source	Why?
Transportation and Climate Initiative	Reduce GHG emissions by changing driving behavior
Innovative and Expanded Tolling	Create toll equity; change driving behavior; reduce congestion
Congestion Pricing	Change driving behavior; reduce congestion
Millionaire's Tax	Create a more equitable tax structure
Vehicle Miles Travelled Fee	Change driving behavior; reduce congestion
Raising the Gas Tax	We already do it; raises lots of money; strong tie to transportation

## Local Money Raisers Why should we do it?

Revenue Source	Why?
Value Capture	Create tools to improve transportation and land use at the same time; local control over locally-raised money
Regional Ballot Initiatives	Local control over locally-raised money
Development Impact Fees	Create a predictable system for developers to invest in transportation
Parking Fees	Actually value land at its true cost
Increased Uber and Lyft Fees	Encourage shared rides
