Remember that a study is the first step to establishing a position from which we can advocate. We also passed a resolution to advocate for library hours which improve accessibility for families. Several of our members attended the public meeting on Voting Centers. We are advocating in support of the centers in order to encourage people to vote. There is significant opposition to the concept however. I don't have a crystal ball, but I feel like the Commissioners will likely come down in favor of the concept but defer moving forward until after the general election and possibly until after the legislative session to see what they might do. We'll see. If you talk to your Commissioner, please let them know easy access to polling locations is important.

Our last meeting of the year will be Ashley Thomas with the WFISD. Some of our regular members will be out of town this month, so it is even more important to invite a guest to this meeting. I can think of several issues our members should be interested in, relating to the school district.
