Where and How to Get Petitions

To request petitions, please fill out <u>this google form</u>. Once we know your signature goal, we will mail petitions directly to you.

You can also pick up petitions at a local hub. A list of hub locations is attached to this email.

Where and How to Return Petitions

After you have done a quality check on your petitions, please mail them to the LWVC office:

If you return them to a hub, please report the **number of signatures** you turned in to the LWVC office (<u>amusefisher@lwvc.org</u>), along with the date and place you turned them in. If you skip this step, we will not be able to accurately track your League's impact on Schools & Communities First.

The Basic Rules of Petitions

Please remember:

• Only ONE county per petition; everyone signing a single petition page **must** live and vote in the same county. You can carry multiple petitions – one for each county people live in. Petitions circulators may live anywhere in the state.

- Signers must use **blue or black ballpoint pens** only. No felt tip pens, no fancy colors.
- The printed name must be **legible.** Ask people to correct their own names.
- You must sign and date the bottom part of the petition as the circulator. Read it carefully, and fill in all the information even if it feels redundant. The "place of signing" is the city you are in when you sign as circulator.
