

Who Oversees Them?

 - Sale and transmission of natural gas (interstate)
 - Siting and abandonment of natural gas pipelines and storage facilities
 - Environmental matters re: projects
 - LNG Terminal safety & operations



Who Oversees Them?

- PHMSA Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration
- A LINE
 - oversees safety & security (88)
 - develops regulations
 - Office of Pipeline Safety
 - safety in design, construction, operation, maintenance & spill planning (interstate)

Who Oversees Them?

- PA PUC (intrastate)
 - Direct & Enforce standards



Design, installation, operation, inspection, testing, construction, extension, replacement, and maintenance (6)

Who Overses Them?

- PA Department of Environmental Protection
 - permit process
 - monitor



How smart PIGs keep pipelines safe

Smart PIGs are probes that clean and inspect pipelines to prevent leaks and environmental damage. In a natural gas line, PIGs are powered by natural gas pressure pushing them onward. Outfitted with computers, GPS, sensors and magnets that transmit data to engineers, smart PIGs can pinpoint any signs of trouble.

WHAT THEY LOOK FOR: Stress, corrosion, gouges, dents and cracks.


WHY ARE THEY CALLED PIGS? In addition to being an acronym for Pipeline Inspection Gauges, they also make a squealing noise when running through a pipe.

HOW BIG ARE THEY? When PIGs are used to inspect Duke Energy natural gas lines, they can be up to 18 feet long and can inspect pipes that are up to 30 inches in diameter.



PIPE WALL THICKNESS SENSORS are powerful magnets. CALIPER SENSORS measures any dents on the pipe.

BATTERY AND DATA STORAGE CONTAINER



DRIVE CUPS for propulsion through the pipe. **ODOMETER WHEELS**

keep the PIG centered in the pipe and measure speed and distance traveled.

 - Calcite Geology





Consequences

- Increase vulnerability of at-risk populations




EVOLVING ISSUES

- Law Suits/Legal Action
 - Eminent domain (2700 properties)
 - Wetland assessment
 - PA Constitution Article 1, Section 27
 - DAs Chester Co. & Delco & PA AG- Criminal – endanger life & property
 - Operating Pressures 1480 to 2100 psig (increases risk)



Mariner East – 3 in 1

- Mariner East 1 –8" Refurbish 1930's line completed late 2014 (2018 temporary shut down – sink holes)
- Mariner East 2 Begin in 2017 delays from lawsuits, well pollution, etc; was operational in 2018 . (20") in part, expected 2020 completion
- Mariner East 2x (16") Parallel to #2; still under construction 2020 projected


