LISA MALONE, CANDIDATE FORUM COORDINATOR AND 2024 VP!

Lisa likens her Forum coordinator role to that of a wedding coordinator. She's planning (several) big events in October, each one bringing together two parties, a venue, a LOT of logistics, and support personnel, including an American Sign Language interpreter and livestreaming support. So far, she's got forums going for District 20 House of Representatives, District 6 State Senator, and District 3 County Council. She's also working on a <u>Gubernatorial Forum</u> at DelTech, which is a real plum for the Sussex League!

A retired science teacher originally from College Park, MD, Lisa came from the Boston area to Milton in January 2020 to be closer to her folks. She joined the League because **she believes that everyone should vote**—**and that everyone should be an informed voter**.
