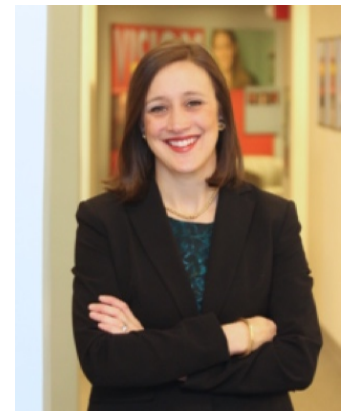


**“The First 2000 Days for First State’s First Learners:
