Here's what you can do to help voters get informed at www.VOTE411.org

Starting May 4, 2020 (when the spring voter guide goes live) ...

- 1. Put a VOTE411 magnet or window cling on your car.
- 2. Facebook...
 - a. Add a VOTE411 Frame to your Facebook profile picture.
 - b. Share posts from the "VOTE411 Delaware" page (@vote411de).
 - c. Change your cover photo to the one from that page (the green one with election dates & deadlines).
- 3. Follow us also on Twitter (@lwvde) and Instagram (@lwvde)
- 4. Distribute VOTE411 handout cards or table tents on checkout counters of nearby essential businesses, or on neighbors' mailboxes.
- 5. Write a simple letter to the editor. Points to make...
 - ➤ Voting is important!
 - ➤ It is easy to find election and candidate information on VOTE411.
 - ➤ All Delaware voters can vote absentee this year. Start at either VOTE411.org or elections.delaware.gov to learn about it and request your absentee ballot(s).
- 6. Post on Nextdoor.com "Have you requested your absentee ballot(s) yet?" (and also "Have you completed your household census yet?"). Both can be done entirely from our own homes during this time of social isolation.

Starting June 9 (a week before the school board election) ...

- 7. If there is a school board race in your district, make a post on Nextdoor.com "Hey, did you know we have a school board election next week? Check the candidate statements on VOTE411.org, and vote on June 16th. It's important! Our kids are our future."
- 8. If you own a business with a signboard, or know someone who does, post a simple message. E.g.: "School board election June 16. See VOTE411.org"
