


#### Gender Balance in State Legislatures












Close enough 80% of the time ("most of the time") in unbiased circumstances





Close enough 95% of the time ("nearly all of the time") in unbiased circumstances





# 239 (45.1%) is NOT CLOSE ENOUGH








20 women & 13 men is within "most of the time" (80%) in unbiased circumstances
