Thank you for your continued interest in the House Redistricting process. Public submissions of plans are still being received through the House Redistricting Website, which will continue to accept submissions until 5:00 pm on **November 5**. Plans may be submitted at: <u>https://redistricting.schouse.gov/plansubmission.html</u>. Previously submitted plans are available on the website <u>https://redistricting.schouse.gov</u>under "<u>Submitted Plans</u>."

Early next week (the week of November 8<sup>th</sup>), a first draft plan of the Redistricting Ad Hoc Committee will be published and made available online on the Redistricting Website at <u>https://redistricting.schouse.gov</u>.

The House Redistricting Ad Hoc Committee will meet on November 10 and, if necessary, November 12 in Blatt Room 110, with provisions for virtual participation by the public, in order to discuss the first draft plan and any public submissions of plans. If you wish to provide in-person testimony at this hearing, please sign up at the sign-up sheet at the beginning of the hearing. If you wish to provide virtual testimony, please email<u>virtualtestimony@schouse.gov</u> by 5:00 pm Tuesday. November 9.
