

SOUTH CAROLINA VOTER REGISTRATION GUIDE

- 1 Check both boxes. Both must be "yes" to be eligible to register to vote.
- 2 Check the appropriate box. For new voters and those who have moved across county or state lines, check "New Registration".
- 3 Add your name, last name first.
- 4 Check the appropriate boxes for Gender and Race and enter the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number.
- 5 Add your residential address. (For students registering at college, this is your dorm address.)
- 6 IF YOUR MAILING ADDRESS IS DIFFERENT, add yours.
- 7 Add your birth date and a contact phone number.
- 8 IF YOUR NAME HAS CHANGED, add your previous name. IF YOU MOVED FROM ANOTHER COUNTY OR STATE, add your prior county/state of residence (and, if you know it, precinct).
- 9 Review the Voter Declaration, and then sign and date your application.

Once the form is completed, it should be returned to the applicant's county voter registration office. Delivery can be by fax, mail or personal delivery of the completed form or by emailing a scanned copy of it.

Voter Declaration – (read and sign below)

I swear or affirm that:

- I am a citizen of the United States of America
- I will be 18 years of age on or before Election Day
- I am a resident of South Carolina, this county and precinct
- I am not under a court order declaring me mentally incompetent
- I am not confined in any public prison resulting from a conviction of a crime
- I have never been convicted of a felony or offense against the election laws OR if previously convicted, I have served my entire sentence, including probation or parole, or I have received a pardon for the conviction
- the address listed above is my only legal place of residence, and I claim no other place as my legal residence

Whoever shall, willfully and knowingly, swear (or affirm) falsely in taking any oath required by law shall be guilty of perjury and, on conviction, incur the pains and penalties of the offense.

ID Required: If you are registering for the first time in this county, you must attach a copy of a current valid photo ID or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck or other government document that shows your name and address in this county. If you do not provide this identification now, you will be required to provide this information when you vote. Voters who are age 65 and over, voters with disabilities, members of the U.S. Uniformed Services or Merchant Marines and their families, and U.S. Citizens residing outside the U.S. are exempt from this requirement.

* Social Security Number (SSN) is required by the S.C. Code § 7-5-170. Applications containing only the last four digits of your SSN will be accepted. Your SSN is used for internal purposes only and eliminates multiple registrations for a single individual. Your SSN is not released to any unauthorized individual.
