Lt. Governor's Centennial Press Conference TUESDAY, AUGUST 18, 2020

At 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 18, 2020, Lieutenant Governor Pamela Evette will hold a press conference on the north side of the S.C. Statehouse in Columbia. LWVSC co-president Holley Ulbrich will be a speaker at the event.

The press conference is to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the ratification of the 19th amendment, granting women's suffrage. This event is also intended to promote women in leadership, voter registration, and census completion through self-response. In addition, Governor McMaster will issue a proclamation in honor of the centennial.

Holley Ulbrich will speak about the importance of women achieving the right to vote.
