PA VOTING REQUIREMENTS: Any U.S.

citizen may vote who is at least 18 years of age, has lived in Pennsylvania for at least 30 days, and has up-to-date registration. Individuals qualified to vote in PA who have moved to another PA district less than 30 days before an election may vote in their former district.

VOTER REGISTRATION: PA residents can register to vote online at **vote.pa.gov**, or in person at PA driver's license centers. Mail-in registration forms are also available at libraries, post offices and other public venues. College students living in PA may register at their college address. To vote for candidates in the primary, you must register by political party; if you do not choose a party, you may vote in the primary only on ballot questions. You may change your party affiliation anytime during the registration period.

POLLING PLACES: You vote in the district in which you are registered. Locations of polling places are listed in your local newspaper, at **vote.pa.gov**, and at **vote411.org**.
