The California Legislature is well into its 2021 session, and the work of the LWVC Advocacy team has begun. Each year, the Board approves legislative priorities for the political session. Attached are the recommended priorities recently approved and submitted by the Legislation Committee. These priorities align well with established Program priorities.

 - Racial Justice Act for All (co-sponsor)

Other Legislative Issues - as time and resources permit.

- Support requests from local Leagues and ILOs for advocacy on bills of specific interest to their jurisdictions
- Act as appropriate another core issues like the Initiative and Referendum Process and Open Government
- Consider Program Director recommendations for action on the highest priority bills in their program areas.
