


Voter Education - Vote By Mail

WAYS TO VOTE

Vote by mail, in person early, or at the polls on election day.





- Mail:
- Postage prepaid on return envelope
- Postmarked on or before Election Day (Nov. 3)
- Received by Election
 Office within 3 days
 of Election Day

- Drop box:
- Anytime before Election Day 8 pm
- Picked up regularly by Election
 Office
- Countywide

- Polling Place:
- On Election Day: 7 am 8 pm
- Ballots not counted there; taken to election office after 8 pm
- Counted after arrive on Election Day


