



Published in June 2023, this book is written by the daughter-father team of Leah Rothstein, a housing policy expert, and Richard Rothstein, author of the highly influential book *The Color of Law* which refutes the segregation myth that white and black Americans live separately by choice. Just Action explores the solutions to the entrenched inequality that still exists today.
