## MARK your Mail-In Ballot

## **IMPORTANT!**

- When your mail-in ballot arrives, MARK it as soon as possible and return it as soon as possible. To be counted, it must be postmarked by 8:00pm on Election Day and received by the county Elections Office by 5:00pm on November 6th!
- If you make an error when MARKING your mail-in ballot, do not cross out items. Instead, call your county <u>Elections Office</u> (Union County residents: 570-524-8682) for a new ballot.
- To ensure your vote is counted, make sure you put the mail-in ballot into the security envelope, seal the security envelope, and sign the declaration on the outside of the Official Election return envelope!
- Voters with disabilities might need assistance MARKING and returning a mail-in ballot. Click here for an accessible ballot.

## How?

1 Read the instructions provided!

2 Mark your mail-in ballot using a blue or black pen

3 Put your mail-in ballot into the plain secrecy envelope and seal it!

4 Put the sealed secrecy envelope into the Official Election return envelope

5 Sign the declaration on the Official Election return envelope to ensure that your vote is counted

Fill out the date, **print** your name and your address, and seal the Official Election return envelope
