

- District Attorney
 - Prosecuting Attorney
 - Represents the state within their district
- Judge of the Civil Court
 - Handles civil cases of up to \$25,000 in claims
 - E.g. credit card debts, small claims, no fault cases, name changes, landlord-tenant disputes
 - Serves ten-year term; can continue serving until the age of 70 if reelected
 - Annual salary of \$193,500
 - Countywide and district-level positions
- Surrogate Court Judge
 - Handles cases involving estates of the deceased and affairs of their living relatives, as well as adoptions
 - Serves 14-year terms; can continue serving until the age of 70 if reelected
 - Annual salary of \$208,000
 - Countywide position
- Supreme Court Judge
 - Handles cases for crimes prosecuted by indictment and civil cases in excess of a \$25,000 claim
 - Serves 14-year terms; can continue serving until the age of 70 if reelected
 - Countywide position
- Male/Female District Leader
 - Represents the party members in their district to the greater political party apparatus
 - Works with community organizations to identify and advocate for community needs before elected officials and government agencies
 - Votes for the party county chairman
 - Serves two-year terms; no term limits
 - Unpaid
- Delegate/Alternate Delegate to the Judicial Convention
 - Attends the judicial convention; casts vote for candidates for party nominees in general election
 - Learns about the individuals running for NY Supreme Court
- Member of the City Council
 - Monitors city agencies
 - Makes legislative decisions, especially those regarding land use
 - Approves the city budget
 - Serves as a check against the mayor
 - Annual salary of \$148,500
- Male/Female State Committee Member
 - Represents party members in their district to the state party apparatus
 - Votes to endorse candidates for statewide office
 - Elects delegates to national party conventions

- Writes the state party's platform
 - Elects state party leadership
- County Committee Member
 - Represents a small area, like a block or two
 - Chooses local judicial candidates
 - Chooses the party nominee in special elections
