General Information

Minimum age is 18. Must register 30 days prior to any primary, special or general election. An individual who is 17 but will be 18 no later than the General Election date in November may register during the preceding year and vote in the primary even though they are only 17. Mail-in registration forms must be postmarked at least 30 days prior to the election in which you wish to vote.

Thirteen judges are elected by the General Assembly from the state at large for six-year terms. The circuit elects a solicitor for each court for a 4-year term in the general election. Oconee and Anderson Counties are in the 10th Judicial Circuit.
