A \$500 cash prize will be awarded and the winner’s artwork will be showcased online. This contest is free to enter.

ARTWORK ENTRIES

All entries must be submitted electronically.

Entries must be in EPS or JPEG file formats with a resolution of 300 dpi.

File must be at least 2 mb.

RULES

Contest is open to all Bucks County high school seniors.

All entries should reflect the theme of “What Voting Means to Me.”

Open to individuals only, no collaborative entries.

Winner will be selected by a panel of judges.

Original photography is accepted.

Electronic artwork is allowed.

The entry will be the entrant’s own creation and idea.

If your entry portrays any identifiable individual(s), provide a model release form signed by the individual or their guardian.

Any image of an offensive or partisan nature will not be accepted.

Contestant agrees that by submitting they are providing LWV Bucks County with a royalty-free perpetual license to use, reproduce and display the image.

There is one entry allowed per person.

Submission due by February 28, 2020.

The winner will be announced on April 30, 2020.
