- if voter has NEITHER of the above forms of ID, voter must request a mail-in ballot application BY MAIL

By MAIL

REQUIREMENTS

- a valid PA driver's license or PennDOT ID
- if voter has NEITHER of the above forms of ID, voter must provide last 4 digits of social security number

IN PERSON

- Go to your county
 Elections Office to
 pick up a mail-in
 ballot application
 form. You can fill
 it out and submit
 it there.
- Get a paper mail-in ballot application form in any **ONE** of these ways:
 - DOWNLOAD an application form by clicking <u>here</u>. Scroll down to "Option 2: Apply for a Mail-in Ballot by mail" and follow the link under Step 1.
 - **CONTACT** your **Elections Office** to have an application mailed to you.
 - Don't have a printer?, click here.
 Scroll down to "Option 2: Apply for a Mail-in Ballot by mail" and click under "Don't have a printer?" in Step 1.
- Fill out the online mail-in ballot application:
 - Click the "I'm not a robot" box; then click "Begin your application".
 - Answer questions about the type of ballot you need: 3 NO answers required for a mail-in ballot.
 - **Provide** your Applicant Information, Identification, and Current Address.
 - **Decide** whether you want automatic mail-in ballots for the rest of the year.
 - "Sign" your declaration. Review your information: if all is current, click Submit.

- Fill out the paper mail-in ballot application using instructions
- Deliver the mail-in ballot application to your county Elections Office by EITHER:
 - Mail it via postal mail.
 - **Drop** it off in person.
